

Dear fellow citizens,

An old World War II-dud that weighs about 250 kilogram was found in the area of Neustraße 10 (backyard towards the seminary / Priesterseminar) on Tuesday, 28th of June 2016.

The bomb will be deactivated on Friday, July 1st at 9 p.m. in the evening.

To ensure your safety, it is necessary to evacuate the area 500 meters around Neustraße 10. The access roads to the restricted area will be locked at 7 p.m.

As an affected person, you have to leave your home

on Friday evening, July 1st by 8 p.m. at the latest (until approx. 11 p.m.)

The deactivating process will approximately be done at 9 p.m. on Friday.

Maybe you can stay with friends and family during that time. If not, you can also come to

During evacuation (5 p.m. to 8 p.m.) there is a **shuttle bus** every 10 minutes to take you safely to these shelters. After the deactivation of the bomb they take you back.

Bus route to Friedrich Wilhelm Gymnasium:

Departure from Mustorstraße with stops at Konstantinbasilika / Modehaus Marx, Stadtbibliothek/ Bundespolizei, Stadtbad and Friedrich Wilhelm Gymnasium

Bus route to Berufsbildende Schule für Gewerbe und Technik:

Departure from Barbarathermen with stops at Am Hügelchen, Rathaus, Karl-Marx Haus, Nikolaus-Koch-Platz, Treviris-Passage and Deutschherrenstraße (Berufsbildende Schule GuT)

In case you are mobility impaired or need other kinds of help, please **call the citizen phone: 0651 / 718-1817**. You will get any kind of information there.

We would like to inform you that experts proceed from the assumption that the dud does not pose a risk. Until the disablement can be done on Friday evening, the place of recovery will be overseen constantly.

We hope to have given you all necessary information and apologize in terms of your own safety for any inconvenience.
